### County Road Needs Report for urban areas

Mr. Mahoney reviewed several proposed county road projects and showed drawings on the screen: Dent Road, Wernett Road from Road 76 to Road 84, Rivershore Development Study, Glade North Road Overlay III, and Wernett Road III from Road 72 to Road 76 (Exhibit 1). There is currently \$50,000 of available funding that can be used on an urban area project. The Board asked Mr. Mahoney to prepare additional information about the Dent Road and Glade North Road projects.





### **DENT ROAD WIDENING**

Improvements on Dent Road North of Burns Road





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


# RIVERSHORE DEVELOPMENT STUDY


Study for Road Construction in Rivershore Area




## **GLADE NORTH ROAD OVERLAY III**


First Mile of All-weather Treatment for Glade North Road






