Commissioners' Proceedings for May 27, 2015

The Honorable Board of Franklin County Commissioners met on the above date. Present for the meeting were Chairman Brad Peck, Chair Pro Tem Rick Miller, Commissioner Robert E. Koch, Interim County Administrator Jerrod MacPherson, and Clerk to the Board Valerie Loffler. The meeting convened at 9:00 am with the Pledge of Allegiance.

### **OFFICE BUSINESS** (9:02 a.m.)

At 10:59 a.m. Senior Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Janet Taylor announced a 15-minute executive session pursuant to RCW 42.30.140(4) to discuss labor negotiations. The meeting reconvened at 11: 15 a.m.

At 11: 15 a.m. Chairman Peck announced another 20-minute executive session pursuant to RCW 42.30.110(1) (g) to discuss the performance of a public employee. The meeting reconvened at 11:38 a.m.

# OTHER BUSINESS (11:39 a.m.)

Chairman Peck discussed current applicants for the TRAC Advisory Board. One applicant is ineligible because she lives outside the County. The other applicant is David Dorsett. Without objection, the Commissioners agreed to appoint Mr. Dorsett. A formal resolution will follow on the Consent Agenda for June 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Commissioner Koch asked for thoughts on ATV's in Franklin County. Chairman Peck responded that he wants the Sheriff to play into any decision.
