CALL TO ORDER

Commission Chairman Robert Koch called the Franklin County Commissioners' Regular Board Meeting to order at 9:00 a.m., in the Commissioners' Meeting Room in the Franklin County Courthouse located at 1016 North Fourth Avenue, Pasco, Washington.

Staff Present: County Administrator Keith Johnson, Sheriff Jim Raymond, Human Resources Director Carlee Nave, County Engineer Craig Erdman, and Clerk to the Board Karin Milham

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Commissioner Koch led the Pledge of Allegiance

PUBLIC HEARING VACATION OF HORSESHOE LANE

County Engineer Craig Erdman presented the Board with Resolution 2017-331, Vacation of Horseshoe Lane.

On April 16, 2017, the Public Works office received a petition signed by 2 landowners adjoining Horseshoe Lane requesting that Horseshoe Lane be vacated. The petition was accompanied by a cash bond as required.

On June 28, 2017, pursuant to Chapter 12.08.010 of the Franklin County Code, the Board accepted the petition and ordered the County Engineer to report thereon; and the County Engineer has completed said report and presented it to the Board.

A public hearing was scheduled for November 8, 2017 in order to consider said vacation. Notice of the hearing was advertised in accordance with the law on October 26, 2017 and November 2, 2017 in the official newspaper of the County.

Commissioner Koch recessed into a Public Hearing at 9:07 a.m., to accept public testimony regarding Resolution 2017-331, Vacation of Horseshoe Lane.

Commissioner Koch asked for Public comment. Toni Meacham represented her parents Pamela and Donald Pierson who are owners of the property. Ms. Meacham stated that the road had no purpose except to land owners and neighbors who have access. It is of no use to the County. Commissioner Koch asked for any other comments and hearing none, closed the Public Hearing and reconvened the Regular meeting at 9:09 a.m. and called for a motion.

Commissioner Peck moved to approve final order of Vacation of Horseshoe Lane, Resolution 2017-331. Commissioner Miller seconded and the motion carried.

County Administrator Keith Johnson presented the Board with information regarding the Memorandum of Understanding between Benton and Franklin Counties for the allocation of Juvenile Justice Center operations. Washington State had changed the census data from ages ten to seventeen years old, to twelve to seventeen years old. The new memorandum has an affect on the calculated cost of allocations between the two Counties.

* Commissioner Peck moved to approve Amendment 1, section 1.A. of the Memorandum of Understanding and Agreement between the Boards of Commissioners of Benton and Franklin Counties for the allocation of Juvenile Justice Center Operations and Facilities Costs.
