CALL TO ORDER

Commission Chairman Brad Peck called the Franklin County Commissioners' Regular Board Meeting to order at 9:00 a.m., in the Commissioners' Meeting Room in the Franklin County Courthouse located at 1016 North Fourth Avenue, Pasco, Washington.

DISCUSSION OF TRAINING/EMPLOYEE MEAL EXPENSES

Auditor Matt Beaton and County Administrator Keith Johnson presented the Board with an issue that arose from reimbursement of funds for training in the Prosecuting Attorney's office for meals provided during a training session. The Auditor concluded internally that it was not appropriate for public funds and thought it was time to clarify whether those expenses are consistent with policy and also get direction from the Board.

It was brought to the attention of the Board that the Public Works department has a clear and concise policy that addresses this type of issue. However, it is written as a Public Works policy and does not address other departments within the County. Since the County does not have a County-wide policy for training and meal expenses, the Prosecuting Attorney's office then is required to follow State guidelines, which they acknowledge they did.

Due to the fact that there is no County-wide policy for departments to adhere to, the Board recommended a policy be written to clarify on said topics concerning training and employee meal expenses.
