Franklin County Emergency Management Director Sean Davis presented a Power Point presentation on the five-year cycle Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan that is required by Washington State Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency. This plan only covers natural disasters.

It is a Multi-jurisdictional plan, which includes Franklin County, City of Pasco, City of Connell, City of Mesa and City of Kahlotus. Information gathered from various public meetings assisted with the updates. Items that have been updated were the statistics, last year's disasters were added and mitigation projects.

In July, the State and FEMA approved the updates to the plan and they will be finalized pending approval of the five jurisdictions.


