Commission Chairman Robert Koch called the Franklin County Commissioners' Regular Board Meeting to order at 9:00 a.m., in the Commissioners' Meeting Room in the Franklin County Courthouse located at 1016 North Fourth Avenue, Pasco, Washington.

9:12 a.m. Feasibility Study Results to transform old KGH Kennewick General Hospital building into a Behavioral Health Recovery Center

Lee Kerr, Two Rivers Health District presented a PowerPoint presentation of the Feasibility Study on the KGH facility to become a behavioral Health Recovery Center. He talked about the background, benefits, and public acceptability. There are two parts to the study, a business plan and repurpose construction costs.

Purchase of existing campus has a one-year agreement to acquire the facilities for \$1.6 Million. The district has \$600.000 to put towards the purchase. He presented a Fund Raising Plan. Mr. Kerr was looking for an endorsement from the Commissioners and pledge of financial support in the future.

9:50 a.m. Conditional Use Permit 2019-07 Expansion of Existing Preschool

Planning and Building Director Derrick Braaten presented a Power Point presentation, which included the background, maps, and photos of what is being proposed for the property. (In accordance with Franklin County Code Section 17.14.040. A proposed use of this type is listed under section E, "Private nursery school, preschool, child mini day-care, and child day-care center' J. The applicant proposes to use the entirety of said property for classrooms, outdoor play area, parking, and a green house. The property where the project is proposed is zoned RS-20, Residential Suburban Zone and carries a "Low-Density Residential" City of Pasco Land Use designation; the property is located in an area known as "West Pasco."

The Planning Department staff provided the Planning Commission with a written recommendation to approve the request for renewal and expansion of the preschool, provided they comply with the conditions of approval. Subsequently, at their meeting on October 27, 2020, the Planning Commission held a duly advertised open-record public hearing and unanimously passed a motion (5-0) to forward a recommendation of approval of the preschool renewal and expansion to the BoCC, with 6 suggested findings of fact, as amended by the Planning Commission.

Commissioner Peck moved to approve Resolution 2020-262 as presented. Commissioner Didier seconded and the motion carried.

- Cliff MacHugh concerned that currently the courts are not scheduling trials, while other
 counties are continuing with zoom and other video resources. Prosecuting Attorney
 Shawn Sant addressed the concern with a recent rule change that came out that allows
 trials under certain circumstances. It is listed as 5-E and was released on November 13,
 2020.
- Shelly Burt asked the Commissioners to look to a County in Colorado as an example to move forward with opening businesses in Franklin County.
- Anonymous- encouraged the Commissioners to reach out to Pendleton Oregon for information on the Feasibility study on the Recovery Center, The Commissioners could find out how their centers have affected the Pendleton community.
