

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP)

SECTION I. CONDITIONS AND INSTRUCTION

- A. **RFP Intent.** This RFP seeks proposals intending to provide maintenance and emergency heating, ventilation, and air conditioning services (HVAC services) for facilities owned by Franklin County including the TRAC Facility, TRAC Pavilion and Franklin County RV Park (hereinafter also collectively referred to as the “Site(s)”). It is the County’s intent through this RFP to obtain HVAC services that maximize equipment and building life, ensure reliable, safe environments for building occupants, and increase the efficiency of the building operational systems.

The County shall have the perpetual option to add to or modify any HVAC services Contract awarded to the Bidder/Contractor to incorporate equipment or building systems that are acquired or abandoned after the Contract is signed.

- B. **Proposal Preparation.** All proposals shall be typed or printed in ink, prepared on the form furnished by Franklin County (Appendix A) and signed by an authorized person of the Bidder’s firm. If errors are made, the person signing the proposal shall initial and date the corrections.
- C. **Preparation of Envelopes.** Each Bidder shall place three (3) separate originals of the proposal in a sealed envelope. On the front of each envelope, place the following information:

- D. **Submission of Proposals.** **Sealed bids must be received by 8:30 am Pacific Standard Time on March 19th, 2019.** The sealed bids will be opened during the Franklin County Commissioner meeting on **March 19th, 2019 at 9:00 am Pacific Standard Time.** Any proposal may be withdrawn, upon the written request of the submitter and received by Franklin County by 8:30 am Pacific Standard Time on March 19th, 2019. **All proposals received after the time and date set for proposals to be received will be rejected and returned unopened to the submitter.** Each Bidder shall mail or deliver three originals of the proposal to:

- E. **Site Visitation.** A **mandatory** walk-through of the facilities will be **March 5th, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. Pacific Standard Time.** Please see page 12 for details. Questions or concerns may be directed to Jason Didesidero, Operations Manager at (509)542-5920 for the TRAC Center, TRAC Pavilion and Franklin County RV Park.
- F. **Bidder's Representation.** The Bidder by making its proposal represents that it has read and understands the terms, conditions, and specifications of this RFP; and has visited the Sites and familiarized itself with the local conditions under which the work is to be performed.
- G. **Prequalification.** Prior to the award of the contract, each Bidder shall be required to submit evidence of sufficient facilities, equipment, experience and financial ability to insure completion of the work, unless waived by the County.
- H. **Award of Contract.** If a contract is awarded it shall be awarded during the Franklin County Commissioner meeting on Tuesday, **March 26th at 9:00 a.m. Pacific Standard Time,** unless the County at its sole discretion decides otherwise on such date. Award of a contract, when made by the County, will be to the Bidder whose bid is the most favorable, taking into consideration price and other evaluation factors outlined in the evaluation criteria. Unsuccessful Bidders will be notified of results in writing within one (1) week of contract award.
- I. **Rejection of Proposals.** The County reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, to waive minor deviations from the specifications, to waive minor informalities in RFP process whenever it is in the County's best interest.

SECTION II. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- A. **General Specifications.** The period for which building environmental systems maintenance is to be provided in accordance with these specifications shall commence on April 1, 2019 and shall continue for a period of three (3) years ending March 31, 2022.

The successful bidder (hereinafter called "Contractor") shall execute an appropriate contract with Franklin County for a term of three (3) years which shall be subject to, and incorporate by reference all bid documents including the Conditions and Instructions, Specifications, and any Addenda. The Contractor shall submit, with this proposal, appropriate Contract documents signed by an authorized Contractor representative.

- B. **Scope of Work.** Unless otherwise stated, the Contractor shall furnish all labor, supervision, materials, tools, construction equipment, transportation, and other items of work and costs necessary to complete the specified work.
- C. **Contracting Officer.** The TRAC General Manager, or his/her designated representative, will be the County's contact person for the Contractor. The County's contact person will oversee performance and completion of the Contract pursuant to its terms and receive, review, and process billings from the Contractor for services accepted by Franklin County.

D. **Intent of Specifications.** The apparent silence or omission of the specifications as to any detail of any work to be done or materials to be furnished means that the best general practice is to prevail, and that material and workmanship of the best quality are to be used, and interpretation of the specifications shall be made upon this basis.

E. **Contractor.** The Contractor shall be licensed to do business in the State of Washington and shall submit a copy of its current business license with their proposal.

F. **Security.**

- ◆ **Bid Security.** Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check, money order or a bid bond in favor of the Owner in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid. The check, money order, or bid bond will be held as a guarantee that the successful bidder will, within ten (10) days from the date of notification of award, furnish the required contract bonds and enter into a contract with the County. Failure to furnish this bid bond will cause the Contractor's proposal to be rejected and the County shall consider other proposals that have met all specified requirements.
- ◆ **Contract Security.** As security for the performance of this Contract, the Contractor will be required to furnish a performance, payment and maintenance bond, in an amount equal to 100% of the contract sum.

G. **Insurance.** The Contractor shall obtain and maintain continuously and provide evidence thereof with his proposal, the following insurance coverage:

- ◆ General Liability Insurance on an occurrence basis, with a combined single limit of not less than \$1,000,000 each occurrence for bodily injury and property damage. It shall include contractual liability coverage for the indemnity provided under the Contract.
- ◆ Workmen's Compensation Coverage as required by Washington State Department of Labor and Industries.
- ◆ Automobile Liability coverage with a combined single limit, or the equivalent of not less than \$500,000 each accident for bodily injury and property damage, including coverage for owned, hired and non-owned vehicles.
- ◆ The Contractor shall furnish acceptable insurance certificates to the County at the time it submits this proposal. There shall be no cancellation, material change, reduction of limits or intent not to renew insurance coverage(s) without thirty (30) days written notice from Contractor or its insurer(s) to the County.

H. **Contractor's Failure to Perform.** The Contractor shall be prepared to start work in accordance with the specifications on April 1, 2019. Failure to complete the work as

scheduled will result in written notice to the Contractor terminating its right to proceed as to the whole or any part of the Contract.

I. **Compliance with Laws and Regulations.** The Contractor shall fully comply with all federal, state, county, and city rules and regulations that may be applicable to the work performed by the Contractor.

- ◆ Non-discrimination policy. It is the policy of Franklin County that no person shall be subjected to discrimination in the County or by its subcontractors because of race, color, national origin, sex, age, religion, creed, marital status, disabled or Vietnam era veteran status, or the presence of any physical, mental, or sensory handicap. The Contractor shall provide a written copy of its non-discrimination policy signed by an executive officer of the Contractor.
- ◆ Contractor shall pay greater than or equal to current prevailing wages in Franklin County. Before payment, Contractor and each subcontractor shall submit a “Statement of Intent to Pay Prevailing Wages” to the TRAC General Manager at 6600 Burden Blvd, Pasco, WA 99301, which has been approved by the State Department of Labor and Industries. Filing fees for the approval of “Statements of Intent to Pay Prevailing Wages” and “Affidavits of Wages Paid” shall be borne by the Contractor.

SECTION III. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

A. **Scope of Work.** The Contractor shall provide comprehensive support programs for the TRAC Center, TRAC Pavilion and Franklin County RV Park Mechanical, Heating, Temperature Control and Air Conditioning Systems to maintain them in good operating conditions in accordance with the terms and conditions herein set forth as minimum requirements. The Contractor shall furnish to the County a written report upon the completion of all preventive maintenance or emergency service calls detailing all work performed and parts replaced.

The Contractor shall assume all responsibility for providing preventative maintenance, parts repair and replacement, and emergency service. This responsibility includes furnishing all labor and/or materials, parts, lubricants, test equipment and special tools.

The intent of this specification is to have the Contractor perform all services defined in the scope of this work and not subcontract specific services. The Contractor shall be available for additional emergency services work over and above the scope of maintenance HVAC services work in the Contract. The Contractor will not proceed with any additional work without written permission from the County and shall complete work as expediently as possible after receiving approval.

B. **Emergency Response.** At the request of Franklin County, Emergency Service Response shall be provided by the Contractor 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, and 365 days per year with a minimum of two on-call technicians. The Contractor must have a full-time

dispatcher and include a local phone number with its submitted proposal. Emergency service, including overtime that is necessary to keep the equipment in good operating condition shall be performed with reasonable promptness and minimal downtime.

The Contractor shall submit in its proposal the hourly rate for emergency services with acknowledgment said hourly rate shall be pro-rated by the Contractor for services provided in less than one-hour increments. Total costs accrued by the Contractor for emergency services requested and approved by Franklin County shall not exceed forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) for the term of the Contract.

Contractor must respond to emergency service calls within one (1) hour after notification by making telephone contact with Franklin County, and arrive on site within four (4) hours. Contractor must respond to non-emergency service calls within twenty-four (24) hours or as arranged with Franklin County. Any failure by the Contractor to comply with the aforesaid response times shall subject the Contractor to a penalty up to five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per occurrence at the sole discretion of Franklin County and payable by the Contractor within thirty (30) days of invoicing from Franklin County. In addition, any failure by the Contractor to comply with the aforesaid response times may at the sole discretion of Franklin County be deemed a material breach of any contract between Franklin County and the Contractor hereby granting Franklin County the right to immediately terminate said contract without notice to the Contractor.

When emergency service is made at the County's request, at times other than when the Contractor would have made a scheduled preventive maintenance call, and the inspection does not reveal any defect required to be serviced under this Contract, the Contractor may charge the County the prevailing service labor rate.

- C. **Existing Equipment Condition.** The Contractor will accept responsibility of all equipment "As-Is" after thirty (30) days from the signing of the Contract. The equipment covered under this Contract is, to the County's knowledge, in maintainable condition and eligible for maintenance agreement. During the first thirty (30) days, Contractor shall evaluate all Sites' equipment and shall provide a written report documenting equipment that is currently in a failed or failing condition. Within thirty (30) days of receipt of the written report the County shall, at its option, either repair the equipment, contract with Contractor to repair the equipment, or remove equipment from the Contract scope.

It is the Contractor's responsibility to identify any equipment that is present in the facility and not listed below or equipment that is on the list below but no longer present in the facility. All equipment discrepancies shall be notified to the County before submittal of a final proposal so that County may amend proposal documentation to include such equipment. Any omissions do not relieve the Contractor of the responsibility of maintaining omitted equipment as a part of this Contract.

- D. **Replacement Parts.** All replacement parts will be new. Reconditioned components may only be used when new parts are not available or when given written authorization by Franklin County.

- E. **Schedule.** Contractors must provide with its proposal a schedule of the dates of all proposed scheduled preventive maintenance inspections and the quantity of Site visits broken down by month. Failure to do so will result in rejection of Contractor's proposal. Preventive maintenance and service work shall be performed during normal working hours of the regular working day. Normal working hours are considered 8:00 a.m. through 5:00 p.m. Pacific Standard Time.
- F. **Personnel.** The Contractor shall use trained personnel in their direct employ when providing services under the Contract. These individuals must be factory trained to keep all equipment included in this proposal properly maintained. If Contractor seeks to use subcontractors on any component of this project it shall at least fourteen (14) days in advance of said project provide to Franklin County a written explanation and detailed financial information and qualifications of subcontractor, which shall then be reviewed by Franklin County and subjects to its sole approval.

Preference will be given to contractors who have at least two qualified technicians living within fifty (50) miles of Franklin County facilities to assure response time is minimal in the event of an emergency. Minimizing downtime is a high priority of Franklin County.

Contractor must maintain in his/her direct employ a minimal staff of not less than four technicians who are qualified to maintain equipment under this Contract in order to assure emergency service coverage during the absence of the primary technician or service mechanic.

Due to the nature of business conducted at Franklin County, all Contractor employees or its County approved subcontractors which work within restricted areas must pass a background check and be fingerprinted by the Franklin County Sheriff's Office before being issued an i.d. badge. (If a badge assigned to the Contractor, its employee, or its subcontractor is lost or an employee of the Contractor or subcontractor is terminated, Franklin County must be notified by the Contractor within twenty-four (24) hours).

- G. **The Contractor.** A minimum of five (5) years' experience in the Temperature Control/HVAC industry is required to qualify as a bidder.
- H. **The County.** Mechanical drawings will be made available for on-site review of all bidders by appointment prior to the bid opening. Reasonable access to the equipment shall be provided to the bidders by appointment prior to the bid opening. Reasonable means of access to the equipment being serviced shall be provided to the Contractor. The Contractor shall be permitted to start and stop all equipment necessary to perform preventive maintenance and emergency services. Start and stop of equipment should be arranged with the County's representative.

SECTION IV. PLANNED SERVICE MAINTENANCE

The Contract requires a minimum of four (4) scheduled maintenance inspections by the Contractor including one spring cooling inspection, one fall heating inspection, one mid-summer filter maintenance, and one mid-winter filter maintenance. In addition to the scheduled HVAC inspections the Contractor will also be required to perform one (1) annual controls verification.

A. General Maintenance Instructions

The Contractor shall perform all the following:

- ◆ Verify all HVAC equipment and its operation (see attached equipment list)
- ◆ Verify and calibration of all DDC temperature control systems.
- ◆ Verify calibration of all pneumatic temperature control systems.
- ◆ Complete systems analysis and operational check of all HVAC systems and sequences.
- ◆ Adjust heat/cool set points and occupancy schedules as directed.
- ◆ Lubrication and adjustment of blowers, pumps, fans, bearings, belts, and sheaves
- ◆ Water treatment- Testing and treatment; including chemicals for all hot water heating, chilled water and cooling tower systems.
- ◆ Hot Water Heating Boilers-Inspection, cleaning, adjustment and annual combustion analysis of hot water heating boilers to ensure safe, clean and efficient operation.
- ◆ Air & Water Cooled Chillers-Inspection cleaning and adjustment of chillers to ensure proper operation refrigerant levels
- ◆ Clean up after your work.
- ◆ Any repairs found at the time of inspection will be documented and brought to Franklin County's attention in writing.

B. HVAC Systems-Maintenance

Annual Spring Cooling Maintenance. Contractor shall perform verification of Franklin County cooling systems operation to maximize equipment performance and efficiency. During this verification all air filters will be replaced with pleated high efficiency filters, belts will be replaced (as needed) and cooling operation will be thoroughly tested and adjusted for optimum performance. Contractor shall perform additional checks to include inspection and lubrication of all motors' bearings and bushings, inspection and cleaning of evaporator and condenser coils, fan blades and blower wheels, inspection and tightening of all electrical connections and wiring, adjustment of refrigerant levels.

Mid-Summer Inspection. During Mid-Summer inspection all air filters will be replaced, belts will be adjusted and proper cooling operation will be verified by the Contractor.

Annual Fall Heating Maintenance. Contractor shall perform verification of Franklin County heating systems operation to maximize equipment performance and efficiency. During this verification all air filters will be replaced with pleated high efficiency filters, belts will be replaced (as needed) and heating operation will be thoroughly tested and adjusted for optimum performance. Contractor shall perform additional checks to include inspection and lubrication of all motors' bearings and bushings, inspection and cleaning of evaporator and condenser coils,

fans and blower wheels, inspection and tightening of all electrical connections and wiring, adjustment of refrigerant levels on heat pumps, and combustion efficiency testing on gas heat units.

Mid-Winter Maintenance. During Mid-Winter inspection all air filters will be replaced, belts will be adjusted and proper heating operation will be verified by the Contractor.

HVAC Contractor Qualifications. Contractor must have qualified technicians with a minimum of five (5) years' experience in trouble shooting and maintaining similar HVAC systems. Due to the amount of equipment covered under this Contract Contractors must have available employee qualified technicians trained and certified in the operation, servicing, and maintaining of the HVAC systems. Contractor's technicians must be trained, certified and capable of operating, testing and troubleshooting of boilers, chillers pumps and all associated equipment to ensure proper operation of complete HVAC systems.

C. Temperature Control Systems-Maintenance

- a) **Annual HVAC Controls Maintenance.** Contractor will verify overall system operation via the system software and physical verification. In addition heat/cool set points and occupancy schedules will be reviewed and adjusted if necessary by the Contractor.
- b) **Controls Maintenance Instructions.** Contractor will check out and verify all of the temperature control systems and components via the system software and/or physical verification.
- c) **Calibration of all stand alone, DDC and pneumatic temperature controls.** Contractor will perform complete system analysis and operational check of temperature control sequences. Heat/cool set points and occupancy schedules will be reviewed and adjusted by the Contractor as requested by Franklin County.
- d) **On-line Support.** A service specialist will be made available by Contractor to aid in analyzing problems and recommending possible solutions via direct phone line modem or internet connection to your control system.
- e) **Sensor Controllers.** Contractor shall perform an operations check, calibration check, determine if sensors are measuring temperature and other conditions properly, ensure proper proportional band settings and visual equipment/air supply inspection.
- f) **Valves.** Contractor shall inspect stem and packing, lubricate/repack or rebuild valve if needed, and check for tight close-off leakages. Contractor shall perform operational inspection.
- g) **Valve Actuators.** Contractor shall perform pressure check to ensure proper operations, inspect for leaks in diaphragms/air connections, loose fittings and corrosion and adjust/calibrate positioners.
- h) **Dampers.** Contractor shall inspect dampers/linkages and adjust if necessary, clean and lubricate dampers and linkages and perform operations check, as well as damper

operators shall perform pressure check; inspect air tubing, bracket connectors and diaphragms, and further relays and switches, perform operations check, check tubing connections and check wiring connections on E/P and P/E relays.

- i) **Controls Qualifications.** Due to the complexity of Franklin County's multiple HVAC/mechanical controls systems; Franklin County reserves the right to require bidding contractors to qualify their bid with current experience of similar types of systems.

See bid requirements below:

- Contractor must have qualified technicians with a minimum of five (5) years' experience in trouble shooting and maintaining similar DDC systems. Due to the amount of Alerton BAC talk & Carrier Comfort Network DDC Controls, contractors must have available employee qualified technicians trained and certified in the operation, servicing, maintaining and programming of these systems.
- Contractor must list at least 3 HVAC maintenance contracts with facilities that have Alerton brand DDC HVAC Controls Systems.
 - List each facilities Name, Address, phone number and contact reference.
- Contractor must list at least 3 HVAC maintenance contracts with facilities that have Carrier brand DDC HVAC Controls Systems.
 - List each facility's Name, Address, phone number and contact reference.
- Contractor must provide company qualifications with large HVAC controls systems that utilize wide-area-networks for communications between DDC control modules, including experience with BACnet communication protocols, and including the following:
 - List each facility's Name, Address, phone number and contact reference.
 - List company employee résumés with experience in HVAC DDC controls and equipment wide-area-networks communications.
- Contractor must provide company qualifications with integrating multiple HVAC DDC manufacturers' control systems that utilize BACnet and CCN communication protocols.
 - List each facility's Name, Address, phone number and contact reference.
 - List company employee résumés with experience in HVAC DDC controls and equipment wide-area-networks communications.
- Contractor must list current employed personnel résumés with qualifications in Design/Programming/installation/start-up of Alerton & Carrier brand DDC HVAC controls systems.

NOTE: If this DDC HVAC controls work is to be sub contracted, list sub-contractors information as required below:

- j) **Water Treatment-Maintenance.** Water treatment will be provided by Contractor on all HVAC hot water heating and chilled water cooling systems as well as the cooling towers.

Heating systems will be checked semi-annually, chilled water systems will be checked semi-annually and cooling tower systems will be checked monthly during the cooling season. Glycol levels will be verified for proper freeze protection levels before the heating season begins. Cooling towers will be winterized at the end of the cooling season as required and cleaned and restarted and tested for proper operation prior to the start of the cooling season. Provide all necessary water treatment chemicals to properly maintain all HVAC systems.

Qualifications-The Contractor shall provide water treatment work by qualified water treatment contractor trained and certified in water chemistry. A water treatment sub-contractor may be utilized for this work upon prior approval from Franklin County.

D. General Maintenance Contractor Requirements

a. **Maintenance Reports.** Contractor shall provide written Site specific logbooks for each facility, detailing equipment and controls located at each site. Logbooks shall be updated by the Contractor at each visit to reflect work completed during scheduled or unscheduled visits. Log books will be located at each Site to allow maintenance staff to document concerns, system problems or other related items requiring attention. Each scheduled service visit shall begin with a review of the log by the Contractor. Contractor shall have access to Facility Dude Work Order system and Critical Alarm Features for updates on HVAC repairs and reports.

SECTION V. PLANNED PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE

A. **Temperature Controls.** Contractor shall examine, clean, lubricate, calibrate, and adjust in accordance with the work schedule of preventive maintenance tasks the following: Detailed preventive maintenance task descriptions shall be included with Contractor's proposal and included in contract submittal.

- Pneumatic & DDC Control Systems
- Thermostats and/or pneumatic transmitters
- Temperature Controls
- Receiver Controls
- Humidity Controls
- Electric Controls
- Pressure Controls
- Relays
- Damper Motors/Actuators
- Time clocks
- Pneumatic Switches
- Instrumentation
- Air Compressors
- Air Dryer

- Pressure Reducing Stations
- Control Valves
- Damper bearings, linkages and accessories directly pertaining to the temperature control system
- Auxiliary equipment
- Operator Workstations, Computers & Software
- Variable Frequency Drives
- DDC Controllers: application specifics and programmable global controllers & gateways

- B. **Mechanical Equipment.** Contractor shall examine, clean, lubricate, calibrate, adjust and check the performance of the Franklin County mechanical equipment listed in the tables which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Preventive maintenance schedule and task descriptions for all covered equipment shall be included with Contractor's proposal and contract submittal. Contractor shall (1) provide all filters and belts for equipment requiring filters and belts (2) provide cleaning of heat transfer surfaces including coils, boiler tubes, cooling towers, and condenser tubes are included, (3) Start up and shut down of all air conditioning and refrigeration compressors, and (4) provide annual laboratory oil analysis of all air-conditioning, and refrigeration compressors and an oil change.
- C. **Backflow Preventers.** Contractor shall inspect and test backflow preventers on an annual basis. Repair parts and labor for backflow preventers should not be included in this proposal. Contractor shall provide annual report to the City of Pasco as well as the TRAC Center General Manager. Any repairs to Backflows must be authorized by Franklin County using a time and materials format to complete repair. **(ALL BACKFLOW ANNUAL REPORTS MUST BE DONE AND GIVEN TO THE CITY OF PASCO ALONG WITH FRANKLIN COUNTY NO LATER THAN APRIL 1ST).**
- D. **Hot Water Boilers.** Contractor shall inspect and test hot water boilers on an annual basis. Repair parts and labor for hot water boilers should not be included in this proposal. Contractor shall provide annual report to the TRAC Center General Manager. Any repairs to hot water boilers must be authorized by Franklin County using a time and materials format to complete repair. **(ALL HOT WATER BOILER ANNUAL REPORTS MUST BE DONE AND GIVEN TO THE TRAC CENTER GENERAL MANAGER NO LATER THAN APRIL 1ST).**
- E. **Fire Alarm Equipment.** Contractor shall inspect and test fire alarm systems on an annual basis. Repair parts and labor for fire alarm systems should not be included in this proposal. Contractor shall provide annual report to the City of Pasco as well as the TRAC Center General Manager. **(ALL FIRE ALARM ANNUAL REPORTS MUST BE DONE AND GIVEN TO THE CITY OF PASCO ALONG WITH TRAC CENTER GENERAL MANAGER NO LATER THAN APRIL 1ST).**
- F. **Water Treatment Systems.** Contractor shall service all towers, heating loops and cooling loops.

G. Non-Covered Equipment. The Contractor will not be responsible for the repair or replacement of non-maintainable and/or non-moving parts of the heating, ventilation, or air conditioning systems. Examples of such non-covered items are boiler tubes, boiler sections, boiler refractory, chimney, breaching, refrigeration, evaporators, refrigeration condensers, water coils, steam coils, concealed air lines, fan housings, duct work, electrical power wiring, water, steam and condensate piping. Other non-covered items include safety tests not specified in this proposal, installation of new devices or modifications to any equipment to comply with recommendations or directive of insurance companies, governmental bodies, or for other reasons.

SECTION VI. EVALUATION CRITERIA

The items identified below define the category requirements that shall be utilized by Franklin County to evaluate the proposals. The Contractor must assure that these requirements are adequately addressed in their proposals and all additional submittals in the specifications are submitted with the proposal. Incomplete proposals will be considered non-responsive. Proposals will be evaluated by the following categories of criteria.

A. Organization, Personnel, Facilities Experience 45 Points

1. Provide evidence of the financial stability of the Contractor. Submit the two (2) most current annual reports or complete copies of the two (2) most recent audited financial statements of the Contractor. Provide current Contractor licenses, bid bond and insurance.
2. Provide a description of the range and scope of services that Contractor provides.
3. Submit evidence of experience by providing five (5) references of similar projects in size and scope that the Contractor is currently providing. Provide contact names and phone numbers.
4. Submit resumes of service personnel who are qualified to maintain the equipment and systems owned by Franklin County. Include resumes from subcontractor team members if applicable.
5. If subcontractors will be used, provide a detailed written financial and qualifications summary for each subcontractor.
6. Employ at least two (2) qualified technicians living within a 50-mile radius of Franklin County facilities to assure response time is minimal in the event of an emergency.
7. List DDC qualifications. (See Section V. paragraph A and Section VI., paragraph C.)
8. Previous experience with Facility Dude Work Order and Critical Alarm features.

B. Technical Approach 25 Points

1. Contractors shall respond to and address all items in this Request for Proposal.
2. Contractors shall describe how they plan to accomplish the service required per the manufacturer's requirements including providing a preventive maintenance schedule.
3. Provide a description of the management approach and the Contractors' quality control plans.
4. Provide evidence of a written safety plan and program.
5. Describe how Contractor will respond to and meet emergency requests, minimize downtime, and perform preventive maintenance.
6. Provide a minimum of three emergency telephone numbers for use during other than normal business hours, or a 24-hour number to ensure that service personnel will be able to receive and respond to service calls on a 24-hour basis with minimal response time.

C. Cost**30 Points**

The cost proposal will be evaluated based on the following formula. The lowest responsive bid will receive the maximum points allowable, with all others receiving a percentage of points based on the lowest cost to their cost.
